the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints. To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ.

Principles for Living in God's Mystery

2. Be careful not to confuse complexity as randomness

No matter the mystery:

- Be poor in spirit...instead of proud in spirit
- Be mournful over your sin...instead of concealing or justifying it
- Be gentle to all men...instead of striving with them
- Be merciful to all men...instead of repaying evil for evil
- Be pure in your heart...instead of hypocritical...take time to be holy
- Be a peacemaker...instead of demanding rights, preferences, privileges
- Be accepting of persecution for the name of Christ...instead of running from it
